


Tabs for expanding the side columns appear when at the top of each screen - both in the list of references (left) and within an individual citation (below).






From the top of a results list, expanding the left-hand column will allow you to narrow your search through facets such as publication date and source type.



From within a single citation, expanding the left column will give you the full text options for the source.



From either area, expanding the right-hand box will give you options for printing, emailing, etc.
