


Accessing *The Chronicle of Higher Education*


- 1) In your browser, go to www.chronicle.com
- 2) Click LOG IN (not SUBSCRIBE).



- 3) Below the “Log In” section of boxes, click CREATE AN ACCOUNT.



- 4) Enter your information, using your FURMAN email address. It will not allow you to create a Furman subscription account with any non-Furman email address. Under INSTITUTION, select Furman University.






8) Find the message in your email, and click the big CONFIRM MY EMAIL button.
